However there is a need of such compilation in English and French which are growing as the Muslim languages. 100 GREAT PERSONS OF THE WORLD

(CHRONOLOGICAL)

DIVINE Prophets are the best leaders of the world who guided the mankind to the right path. Prophet Noah was the first prophet who invited the people to worship One God and lead a pious life. They rejected his message and were punished through a large deluge sinking them all. Later Prophet Ibrahim appeared who preached monotheism and good life pattern in Iraq, Egypt and Palestine. All the three Divine religions of the world namely Judaism, Christianity and Islam were preached by his descendants namely Moses, Jesus and Mohammed, be peace upon them all.

The Roman Empire which flourished around Mediterranean for few centuries in BC era was also idolatrous in nature. His ruler Herod Antipas slaughtered Prophet John the Baptist, for the sake of his illegal marriage. Again he chased Prophet Jesus Christ and rejected his Divine message. The Roman Empire continued for few centuries until it was finally eradicated by Muslims in 650 AD. We have clear record of Prophetic Message for 4000 years from Prophet Ibrahim to our time in 2000 AD.

The Greek intellectualism flourished for 500 years from 400 BC then it was ruthlessly suppressed by the Christian preachers. The period between 250 and 750 AD may be termed as the Dark Period of intellectualism when scientists were murdered and their Greek manuscripts were destroyed or heavily locked in the Christian monasteries of Europe.

Muslims were the First to break the locks of monasteries and acquire the pool of Greek knowledge. It is said that the rotten wooden boxes full with manuscripts were weighed in equal gold from Abbasid Caliphate and brought to Baghdad.
